REFUND POLICY OF THE REGISTRATION FEE: The registration fee is a donation towards the operation of NVLL. All other donations collected from fundraisers, sponsorships, etc...are not refundable. In order to receive a refund of the registration fee, the parent/guardian of a player must submit a letter to the Board requesting a refund and stating the reason why the player is resigning. No refunds will be processed without this letter. Amount of refund will be based on the following situations. A player who resigns, quits, dropped or is injured...

-Prior to the beginning of the regular playing season but before uniform is issued, a \$25 administrative fee will be charged and the remaining balance will be refunded.

-After the uniform has been issued and prior to the beginning of the regular playing season, 50% of the registration fee will be refunded.

-No refund of the registration fee will be refunded after the playing season has begun.

NOTE 1: California Abstract Certificate of Birth is no longer a valid Proof of Age document.
Passports are not legal proof of age document.

PROOF OF RESIDENCE DOCUMENTS

Players must provide 3 different categories of proof of residency. Copies will be maintained in the player's folder while he or she is an active player with no break in playing season. Once a player has a break in season (does not play one season) he or she then must again provide 3 proof of his or her current residency to re-register.

There are only two exceptions...rules 2d and 4d. A player that lived within our boundaries and has moved out but continuous to play with our league with no break in playing season qualifies under the 2d rule. The 4d rule is for an adult wavier who volunteers within our league for two years and continues, his or her child is eligible to play.

PARENT AND PLAYER COMMITMENT: Baseball and Softball is a team sport. Managers, coaches and players count on each other to have a cohesive working team. Missing a team practice or game without informing the manager is an unexcused absent. A player with 2 consecutive or 3 total unexcused absents will be benched for a game. Further unexcused absents may lead to a player being dropped from the team. Players with 4 or more excused absence may also be dropped from a team.

UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT: Every player will receive a jersey and hat.

- All male players are required to wear a supporter and we strongly recommend a cup, which is mandatory if he plays catcher.
- Optional Uniform and Equipment
 - Pants, belt, socks and practice jersey is optional. If you wish to purchase them please wait till your son or daughter is selected to a team and the Manager recommends the colors so that the players looks alike. Names on jersey are optional. Teams will decide to have it or not. All optional uniform is at the players cost.
 - Baseball cleats are recommended but not required. Young players may wear soccer cleats. No metal cleats for major players or below. Metal cleats are permitted for Junior/Senior/Big league.
- BATS: NV provides bats but if you wish to purchase your own baseball or softball bat they must meet Little League specifications and standards. Check with league officials for more information.

- GLOVE: We recommend purchasing a leather glove. This type would withstand the wear and tear and sometime the abuse a glove goes through during a season. Glove size for TBall to Major players range from 9" to 12" glove and can not be larger than 12". Get a glove that fits the child's hand that is not to big where it may fall off when the hand is by his or her side. A pitcher can not have white or grey on their glove.

TRYOUTS AND TEAM SELECTION INFORMATION 2009

PLAYER'S AGE BASED ON THE AGE OF PLAYER ON CUTOFF DATE

Baseball: April 30, 2009

Softball: December 31, 2008

AGE GROUP 4 TO 7 YEARS OLD

- No tryouts required
- Will be assigned to a T-Ball team (4-5-6 yr olds) or coach pitch Farm team (6-7-8 yr olds).
- 6 year old may request to play Farm if player has 1 year experience in T-Ball

AGE 8-YEAR-OLD

- Tryout not required
- Players not trying out will be assigned to a coach pitch Farm team.
- Players that tryout will be eligible for the minor draft. Player not selected will play in the coach pitch Farm division.

AGE GROUP 9 YEARS AND OLDER

- Tryouts are required for players 9 years and older
- Players need to attend 50% of the tryouts in order to be eligible for the draft.
- **NO SHOWS for tryouts:**
 - 9-10-11 year olds – Will not be eligible to be drafted to a Major team. Randomly selected to a Minor team after the draft selections. Players are in-eligible to move up to the Major division at a later time unless...note 1
 - 12 year olds will not be eligible to play in the current season and fee refunded based on refund policy
 - Wavier Request: Parent or guardian may submit a letter to the board as to why player did not show-up for tryouts. If approved player will be become eligible for the draft or placed on a team.
- Parent of a 12 year old may request to have player stay down in the minors. Parent must submit letter to board. After board approval request must then be approve by the District Administer. Request must be approved to play in the minors prior to draft or else see refusal to play. If request is disapprove player must play in the majors.
- Major and Minor teams will be selected 1 week after last tryout, Farm and T-Ball soon after. Updates are posted on website.

RETURNING MAJOR PLAYERS

- Returning players on a Major do not need to tryout and will remain on the same Major team.
- Player requesting to be release from a major team must submit a letter of release to the board for approval. Released player must go to tryouts. If released after tryout a player will be placed on a waiting list till an open position in Majors is available. Any refund will be based on the refund policy.

REFUSAL TO PLAY ON A MAJOR TEAM: A player who refuses to be drafted to the Majors or request to stay in the Minors (except for approve wavier) will be ineligible for post-season All-star play. Player will also be ineligible to move up to the Majors for the remainder of the regular season. A player in the minors during the regular playing season who refuses to be moved up to the Majors will continue to play in the minors but restricted to play nine defensive outs, may not pitch in any game. Other restriction may also apply. See player agent or review the By-Laws for complete restrictions placed on a player for refusal to be place on a team.

Sport Parent Code of Conduct

We, the _____ Little League, have implemented the following Sport Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league.

Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and be suspended from the following game. Repeat violations may cause a multiple game suspension, or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games.

Preamble

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles:

- Trustworthiness,
- Respect,
- Responsibility,
- Fairness,
- Caring, and
- Good Citizenship.

The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these “six pillars of character.”

I therefore agree:

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
10. I will teach my child that doing one’s best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
14. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
15. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
16. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
17. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

- Prior to the beginning of the regular playing season and before uniform is issued a \$25 administrative fee will be charged and the remaining balance will be refunded.
- After the uniforms have been issued and prior to the beginning of the regular season, 50% of the registration fee will be refunded.
- There will be no refund of the registration fee after the start of the regular season.
- Mistakenly registering from outside our boundary...there will be a \$5 administrative fee.
